

ORDINANCE 2023-04

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF EAGLE GROVE, IOWA, BY AMENDING PROVISIONS PERTAINING TO MOBILE FOOD VENDORS

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Eagle Grove, Iowa:

SECTION 1. SECTIONS MODIFIED. Section 125.03 and 125.16 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Eagle Grove, Iowa, shall hereby be repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof:

125.03 LOCATION RESTRICTED. Mobile food vendors shall not be able to operate on public streets or on public property unless the Exceptions in 125.16 apply during the application process. Mobile food vendors operating on private property shall be able to operate provided they have a valid license from the City of Eagle Grove.

125.16 EXCEPTIONS. The following are exceptions to being able to operate on public property and shall be eligible to apply for a license under this chapter.

1. Local Residents and Farmers. Local residents and farmers who offer to sell produce during seasonal times of the year.

2. Students. Students representing the Eagle Grove Community School District conducting projects sponsored by organizations recognized by the school or the City.

3. Special Events. Mobile food vendors selling goods as part of an organized special event recognized by the Chamber, the City, and/or the Wright County Fair Board.

4. Club/Service Members. Members of local civic and service clubs recognized by the City.

SECTION 2. REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision, or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 4. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.

On August 21, 2023, the City Council of Eagle Grove, Iowa passed the aforementioned ordinance and a summary is as follows: SECTION 1: Section Modified. Section 125.03 and 125.16 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Eagle Grove, Iowa, is repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof: 125.03 LOCATION RESTRICTED. Mobile food vendors shall not be able to operate on public streets or on public property unless the Exceptions in 125.16 apply during the application process. Mobile food vendors operating on private property shall be able to operate provided they have a valid license from the City of Eagle Grove. 125.16 EXCEPTIONS.
