

ORDINANCE NO. 2024-10

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF EAGLE GROVE, IOWA, BY AMENDING PROVISIONS PERTAINING TO FIRE OFFICIALS AUTHORITY TO CITE VIOLATIONS

Be It Enacted by the City Council of the City of Eagle Grove, Iowa:

SECTION 1. SECTION MODIFIED. Section 35.14 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Eagle Grove, Iowa, is repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof:

35.14 AUTHORITY TO CITE VIOLATIONS. Fire officials acting under the authority of Chapter 10A, Subchapter V, Part 2 of the *Code of Iowa*, may issue citations in accordance with Chapter 805 of the *Code of Iowa*, for violations of Chapter 10A, Subchapter V, Part 2 of the *Code of Iowa* or a violation of a local fire safety code.

(Code of Iowa, Sec. 100.41)

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 3. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

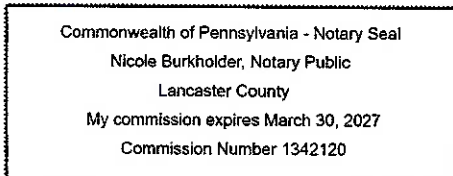
