

Whereupon, Council member Weland moved that the following resolution be adopted:

**RESOLUTION 2021-08**

**A RESOLUTION TO SET A HEARING FOR THE APPROVAL OF MAXIMUM PROPERTY TAX DOLLARS FOR FY 2022**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Eagle Grove will consider the proposed FY 2021-2022 city maximum property tax dollars for the affected levy total, and

**WHEREAS**, a notice concerning the proposed city maximum property tax dollars will be published as required and posted on city web site and/or social media accounts if applicable, and

**WHEREAS**, a public hearing concerning the proposed city maximum property tax dollars will be held on Monday, March 01, 2020 at 6:30 p.m. via electronic means due to the Covid-19 Pandemic and such electronic means shall be available to the public, and

**WHEREAS**, the Maximum Property Tax dollars requested in the total maximum levy for affected property tax levies for FY 2021-2022 represents greater than 102% of the Maximum Property Tax dollars requested for the current FY 2020-2021 and shall require the consideration and approval of a super majority of the City Council of the City of Eagle Grove after a public hearing has been held regarding pursuant to current law, and

**NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved** by the City Council of the City of Eagle Grove, Iowa, as follows:

Section 1. This City Council shall meet on Monday, March 01, 2021, via electronic means where the information is detailed in the public notice affixed to this Resolution, at 6:30 p.m., at which time and place a hearing will be held and proceedings will be instituted and action taken to discuss and potentially define the Maximum Property Tax Dollars requested for FY 2021-2022 described in the preamble hereof.

Section 2. The City Clerk is hereby directed to give notice of the proposed action setting forth the amount and purpose thereof, the time when and place where the said meeting will be held by publication at least once, not less than ten (10) and not more than twenty (20) days before the date of said meeting, in a legal newspaper which has a general circulation in the City. The notice shall be in substantially the following form:
