**RESOLUTION 2021-10**

**A Resolution Approving FY 2021 Maximum Property Tax Dollars**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Eagle Grove have considered the proposed FY 2022 city maximum property tax dollars for the affected levy total, and

WHEREAS, a notice concerning the proposed city maximum property tax dollars was published as required and posted on city web site and/or social media accounts if applicable, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing concerning the proposed city maximum property tax dollars was held on Monday, March 1, 2021 via electronic means available to the public as recommended during the Covid-19 Pandemic, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Eagle Grove that the maximum property tax dollars for the affected tax levies for FY 2022 shall not exceed the following total:

Total maximum property tax dollars requested - \$1,460,939

The Maximum Property Tax dollars requested in the total maximum levy for affected property tax levies for FY 2022 represents greater than 102% of the Maximum Property Tax dollars requested for the current FY 2021.
