RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SUPPORTING 10 EMT/EMTA COUSE TRAINING REIMBURSEMENT AGREEMENTS

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Eagle Grove believes it to be in the best interest of the residents of the City of Eagle Grove and surrounding area to publish and consider the support for 10 new EMT/EMTA Course Training Reimbursement Agreements (AGREEMENTS); and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Eagle Grove hereby encourages residents and interested individuals to contact the City of Eagle Grove if they are interested in becoming an EMT for the Eagle Grove EMS Department; and,

WHEREAS, this Resolution demonstrates the Council's readiness to support training agreements for individuals to become an EMT/EMTA, but this Resolution does not bind the Council to a financial obligation; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EAGLE GROVE, IOWA:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Eagle Grove hereby authorizes the City Clerk and EMS Service Director to seek interested individuals who would benefit from the agreement and wish to become an EMT or an EMTA

SECTION 2. That the City Council of the City of Eagle Grove hereby encourages the City Clerk and EMS Service Director to work with Iowa Central Community College to offer courses to be held at the Eagle Grove Career Academy at the earliest possible time.
