RESOLUTION 2018-16

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION FOR RECREATIONAL TRAIL DEVELOPMENT

WHEREAS, the Mid-Iowa Development Association (MIDAS) Council of Governments is accepting applications for Recreation Trail Projects through the Iowa DOT Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) for Fiscal Years 2019-2022; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Eagle Grove and Eagle Grove residents have been actively discussing trail development in the community, which will expand recreational opportunities and enhance the quality of life for residents; and,

WHEREAS, the proposed trail development will connect the City of Eagle Grove to the existing Three Rivers Trail that currently terminates outside of City limits; and,


WHEREAS, the City will commit local matching funds of at least 20 percent, acquire the necessary land for the trail segment, take responsibility for the recreational trail, and adequately maintain the completed project for its intended public use for a minimum of 20 years following project completion; and,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Eagle Grove does hereby approve committing the financial resources and fulfilling the maintenance requirements that the submission of this grant application entails for the trail connection from the existing Three Rivers Trail to Eagle Grove.
