

Whereupon, Council member Weland moved that the following resolution be adopted:

**Resolution 2018-54**

**RESOLUTION PROHIBITING ON-STREET PARKING ON 2<sup>ND</sup> STREET SE AND 2<sup>ND</sup> STREET SW BETWEEN THE INTERSECTIONS OF COMMERCIAL AVENUE AND KIRKWOOD AVENUE**

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 69.01 Parking Limited or Controlled provides for the protection and limitation of the parking of vehicles by designated traffic control devices; and,

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 61.01 of the City of Eagle Grove Municipal Code of Ordinances establishes how Traffic Control Devices are installed in the City of Eagle Grove; and,

**WHEREAS**, a request was made for the City Council of the City of Eagle Grove to prohibit on-street parking, defined in Exhibit A, on 2<sup>nd</sup> Street SE and 2<sup>nd</sup> Street SW between the intersections of Commercial Avenue and Kirkwood Avenue; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Eagle Grove hereby believe that prohibiting on-street parking along the municipal roadway shown in Exhibit A is in the best interest of the City of Eagle Grove; and,

**NOW BE IT RESOLVED**, the City Council for the City of Eagle Grove hereby approve and authorize the City of Eagle Grove to establish proper traffic control devices along this route, record the installation of traffic control devices, and authorize the Eagle Grove Police Department to enforce adherence to the traffic control devices.


The motion was seconded by Council member Middleton and after due consideration thereof, the roll was called and the following Council members voted:


