

Resolution 2019-109

Resolution calling for a public referendum to authorize the continuation of the local option sales and services tax in the corporate and un-incorporated areas of Wright County, Iowa, at the rate of one percent.

WHEREAS, the 1% local option sales and services tax is scheduled to sunset on June 30, 2021 for certain jurisdictions in Wright County; and


WHEREAS, IAC [721] – 21.800(2) requires motions adopted by the governing bodies representing at least 50% of the population of the County to be filed with the county auditor pursuant to Iowa Code section 423B.1, subsection 4, paragraph “b” requesting submission of a local option sales and services tax imposition, rate change, use change or repeal to the local voters; and

WHEREAS, within 30 days of receiving a sufficient number of motions, the county commissioner shall notify affected jurisdictions of the local option sales and services tax election date; and


WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Eagle Grove, Iowa support holding the special election on the Local Option Sales and Service Tax.
