**RESOLUTION NO. 2019-116**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN APPLICATION FOR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDS FOLLOWING PUBLIC HEARING**

WHEREAS, the City of Eagle Grove is eligible for and intends to apply for Iowa Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding under the Water/Sewer portion of the program; and,

WHEREAS, the City has held a public hearing as required for submission of a CDBG application on December 2, 2019 to hear public comments on the submission of the grant application; and,

WHEREAS, the City has an immediate need to replace aging and deteriorated water and sewer mains on the City's northeast side to ensure adequate and quality water service and sanitary sewer service for the citizens of the target area within the City limits of Eagle Grove; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that 75.88% of the individuals who will benefit from this project meet the definition of low-to-moderate income; and,

WHEREAS, the City has a need for financial assistance to be able to fund the proposed project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EAGLE GROVE, IOWA:

SECTION 1. The City Council authorizes the submission of an application for CDBG grant funds to the Iowa Economic Development Authority in the amount of \$600,000 for the Eagle Grove Water Sewer System Improvements Project.

SECTION 2. The City Council certifies that the required public hearing announcements were made prior to consideration of the grant application, as per CDBG guidelines.

SECTION 3. The Mayor is authorized to sign all paperwork and forms necessary for the submittal of the grant application.
