**A RESOLUTION ENDORSING AN APPLICATION FOR
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDS
FOLLOWING PUBLIC HEARING**

WHEREAS, the City of Eagle Grove is eligible to apply for Iowa Community Development Block Grant funding under the Downtown Revitalization portion of the program, and;

WHEREAS, the City Council has held a public hearing as required for submission of a CDBG guidelines on May 6, 2019 to hear public comments on the submission of the grant application, and;

WHEREAS, the City has designated a portion of the downtown area as an area where blighted conditions exist, and;

WHEREAS, the City Council has decided to submit an application to the CDBG program to provide assistance the building owners to help mitigate blighted conditions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EAGLE GROVE, IOWA:

SECTION 1. The City Council endorses the submission of an application for CDBG grant funds to the Iowa Economic Development Authority in the amount as announced in Public Hearing Announcements for a Downtown Revitalization Program in the designated blighted area.

SECTION 2. The City Council certifies that the attached public hearing announcements were made prior to consideration of the grant application, as per CDBG guidelines.

SECTION 3. The Mayor is authorized to sign all paperwork and forms necessary for the submittal of the grant application.
