RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING FISCAL YEAR 2019-2020 SALARIES AND WAGES

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Eagle Grove has reviewed certain positions and the corresponding compensation within the City of Eagle Grove, and;

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Eagle Grove shall provide and post a public notice prior to each fiscal year defining City of Eagle Grove personnel wage rates, and;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the City Council of the City of Eagle Grove, Iowa, as follows:

Section 1. The following persons and positions shall be paid the bi-weekly salaries or wages indicated.

Section 2. The City Finance Officer is hereby authorized to issue checks, less legally required or authorized deductions from the amounts set out below.

Section 3. Payroll intervals, overtime provisions, and other related payroll personnel procedures shall be conducted in the manners prescribed in the City of Eagle Grove Personnel Policy and the Fair Labor Standard Act.

Section 4. The pay rates for employees and positions employed by, volunteering, or otherwise authorized to perform services for the City of Eagle Grove shall be compensated using the attached Appendix.

Section 5. All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 6. This resolution shall be in full force and effective immediately upon its adoption and approval, as provided by law.
