

Whereupon, Council member Middleton moved that the following resolution be adopted:

**RESOLUTION 2020-07**

**A RESOLUTION TO SET A HEARING FOR THE APPROVAL OF MAXIMUM PROPERTY TAX DOLLARS FOR FY 2021 FOR MONDAY, FEBRUARY 17, 2020 AT 6:30 P.M.**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Eagle Grove will consider the proposed FY 2020-2021 city maximum property tax dollars for the affected levy total, and

WHEREAS, a notice concerning the proposed city maximum property tax dollars will be published as required and posted on city web site and/or social media accounts if applicable, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing concerning the proposed city maximum property tax dollars will be held on Monday, February 17, 2020 at 6:30 p.m. at the Eagle Grove City Hall Council Chambers located at 210 E. Broadway in the City of Eagle Grove, and

WHEREAS, the Maximum Property Tax dollars requested in the total maximum levy for affected property tax levies for FY 2020-2021 represents greater than 102% of the Maximum Property Tax dollars requested for the current FY 2019-2020 and shall require the consideration and approval of a super majority of the City Council of the City of Eagle Grove after a public hearing has been held regarding pursuant to current law, and

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the City Council of the City of Eagle Grove, Iowa, as follows:

Section 1. This City Council shall meet on Monday, February 17, 2020, at the Eagle Grove City Hall Council Chambers, Eagle Grove, Iowa, at 6:30 p.m., at which time and place a hearing will be held and proceedings will be instituted and action taken to discuss and potentially define the Maximum Property Tax Dollars requested for FY 2020-2021 described in the preamble hereof.

Section 2. The City Clerk is hereby directed to give notice of the proposed action setting forth the amount and purpose thereof, the time when and place where the said meeting will be held by publication at least once, not less than ten (10) and not more than twenty (20) days before the date of said meeting, in a legal newspaper which has a general circulation in the City. The notice shall be in substantially the following form:
