RESOLUTION TO SET A DATE FOR PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED PLANS SPECIFICATIONS, FORM OF CONTRACT, AND ESTIMATED COST OF THE PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT FOR THE DOWNTOWN REVITALIZATION FOR THE CITY OF EAGLE GROVE, IOWA

WHEREAS, the City of Eagle Grove (the "City"), in Wright County, State of Iowa, calls for a public hearing to consider and review the proposed plans specifications, Form of Contract, and Estimated Cost of the Public Improvement for the planned downtown revitalization project ("project") and to give notice thereof as required by such law, including notice of the right to petition for an election on such proposal;

WHEREAS, the City of Eagle Grove City Council shall hear comments, both orally and written, for the consideration and review of the project and the meeting will be held at the time and place defined hereto concerning the proposed project;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the City Council of the City of Eagle Grove, Iowa, as follows:

Section 1. This City Council shall meet on June 8, 2020, at the Eagle Grove City Hall Council Chambers, Eagle Grove, Iowa, at 6:30 p.m., at which time and place a hearing will be held and proceedings will be instituted and action taken to review plans, specifications, form of contract, and estimated cost for the project described in the preamble hereof.

Section 2. The City Clerk is hereby directed to give notice of the proposed action setting forth the amount and purpose thereof, the time when and place where the said meeting will be held by publication at least once, not less than ten (4) and not more than twenty (20) days before the date of said meeting, in a legal newspaper which has a general circulation in the City.

Broadway, Eagle Grove, Iowa, 50533 in said City on the 8th day of June, 2020 at 6:30 p.m., at which time and place a hearing will be held on the proposed plans, specifications, form of contract, and estimated of cost for the construction of the Downtown Revitalization for the City of Eagle Grove, Iowa in and for said City. If approved, consideration of such bids for the construction of the aforesaid project will be made following the hearing. Any interested person may appear at said hearing and file objections to the proposed plans, specifications, form of contract, and estimated costs for said improvements. It is anticipated that bids will be received for aforesaid improvements on the 26th day of May 2020 at 2:00 p.m.

Project Scope: Downtown Revitalization for 12 city buildings at various addresses, and related Work indicated in the drawings and specifications.

A more detailed description of the kinds and approximate quantities of materials and types of construction for which bids will be received are set forth in the Bidding Documents prepared by ISG, of Mankato, MN which together with the proposed form of contract, have heretofore been approved by the City Council, and are now on file for public examination in the office of the City Clerk, and are by this reference made part hereof as though fully set out and incorporated herein.

The Architect/Engineer has prepared plans and specifications governing the construction of the proposed improvements. These plans and specifications, and the proceedings of the City referring to and defining said improvements, are hereby made a part of this Notice and the proposed contract by reference, and the proposed contract shall be executed to comply therewith.
