**A RESOLUTION PROMOTING AN EAGLE GROVE POLICE OFFICER TO THE POSITION OF SERGEANT**

**WHEREAS**, the bargaining representatives for the Eagle Grove Police Department and the City of Eagle Grove entered into an agreement allowing for the title of Sergeant and a wage level established; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Eagle Grove Police Chief posted the position's job description and applicable information pursuant to the Agreement between the City of Eagle Grove and the International Brotherhood of Teamsters, Local 238; and,

**WHEREAS**, an interview panel was created that consisted of different members of the City of Eagle Grove and community; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Eagle Grove Police Chief took the recommendations of the interview panel, employment history, and the positions job criteria to recommend the promotion of Officer Mark Hennigar for the Sergeant position, and;

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Eagle Grove hereby wishes to approve the recommendation of the Eagle Grove Police Chief for the promotion of Officer Mark Hennigar to be the new Sergeant effective immediately with an automatic wage adjustment to match the wage level identified for the position as passed by the executed 2019-2022 Agreement between the City of Eagle Grove and the International Brotherhood of Teamsters, Local 238; and,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City Council of the City of Eagle Grove hereby promotes Officer Mark Hennigar to Sergeant.
