RESOLUTION TO SET A DATE FOR PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED PLANS SPECIFICATIONS, FORM OF CONTRACT, AND ESTIMATED COST OF THE PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT FOR THE DOWNTOWN REVIVALATION FOR THE CITY OF EAGLE GROVE, IOWA

WHEREAS, the City of Eagle Grove (the "City"), in Wright County, State of Iowa, calls for a public hearing to consider and review the proposed plans specifications, Form of Contract, and Estimated Cost of the Public Improvement for the planned downtown revitalization project ("project") and to give notice thereof as required by such law, including notice of the right to petition for an election on such proposal;

WHEREAS, the City of Eagle Grove City Council shall hear comments, both orally and written, for the consideration and review of the project and the meeting will be held at the time and place defined hereto concerning the proposed project;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the City Council of the City of Eagle Grove, Iowa, as follows:

Section 1. This City Council shall meet on September 8, 2020, at the Eagle Grove City Hall Council Chambers, Eagle Grove, Iowa, at 6:30 p.m., at which time and place a hearing will be held and proceedings will be instituted and action taken to review plans, specifications, form of contract, and estimated cost for the project described in the preamble hereof.

Section 2. The City Clerk is hereby directed to give notice of the proposed action setting forth the amount and purpose thereof, the time when and place where the said meeting will be held by publication at least once, not less than ten (4) and not more than twenty (20) days before the date of said meeting, in a legal newspaper which has a general circulation in the City.

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, FORM OF CONTRACT, AND ESTIMATE OF COST FOR THE DOWNTOWN REVITALIZATION FOR THE CITY OF EAGLE GROVE, IOWA.

Notice is hereby given that the City Council of Eagle Grove, Iowa, will meet at City Hall, 210 E Broadway Street, Eagle Grove, Iowa on the **8th day of September, 2020, at 6:30 p.m.**, at which time and place a hearing will be held on the proposed plans and specifications, form of contract and estimate of cost for Downtown Revitalization in and for said City. Any interested person may appear at said hearing and file objections to the proposed plans, specifications, form of contract and estimated costs for said improvements.

The project is located in Eagle Grove, Iowa taking place on W Broadway Street, commencing at the intersection of Iowa Avenue and traversing East until the intersection with S Park Street.

The general description of types of construction and limits for which bids will be received shall be as follows:

Reconstruction of parking and sidewalk along the road including permeable pavers in the parking area, stormwater structures and drainage improvements, concrete sidewalk, and soil quality restoration and plantings areas. Also includes standard pavers and colored concrete. Water and sanitary building services will be replaced requiring street patching as needed. Work also includes ADA sidewalk ramps, entryway replacement, minor grading, installation of site amenities and all other miscellaneous work to complete the project.

Plans and specifications governing the construction of the proposed improvements have been prepared by the Engineer. These plans and specifications, and the proceedings of the City referring to and defining said improvements, are hereby made a part of this Notice and the proposed contract by reference, and the proposed contract shall be executed to comply therewith.
