**RESOLUTION DECLARING SURPLUS PROPERTY AND AUTHORIZING SALE AND DISPOSAL THEREOF**

WHEREAS the City of Eagle Grove, Iowa (hereinafter referred to as the "City"), State of Iowa, is a political subdivision organized and existing under the law and the Constitution of the State of Iowa (the "State"); and

WHEREAS the City is the sole owner of the equipment listed in Section 1 which is to be declared surplus property; and

WHEREAS this surplus property should be disposed of or sold to raise additional revenue and prevent the further decline in value thereof prior to sale; and.

WHEREAS the disposal of excess property is in the best interests of the City of Eagle Grove.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EAGLE GROVE, IOWA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 2. The City Council shall set an Auction for Thursday, August 31, 2023 at 4:00 p.m. to dispose of such Surplus Property.
