WHEREAS, the said registered deed holder of the above named property has failed to abate or cause to be abated the above nuisance as directed within the time set, and afer evidence was duly produced and considered at this meeting, and said registered deed holder has failed to file a written request for hearing, as provided, after being properly served by a notice to abate; and,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the enforcement officer be and is hereby directed to serve a copy of this Order upon the said property owner; and,


