**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Eagle Grove is committed to providing public safety for the City of Eagle Grove and the City of Goldfield, and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Eagle Grove now recognize the need to approve the hiring of one new Eagle Grove Police Officer pending successful completion of all pre-employment checks and physicals as required by the City of Eagle Grove, and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of Eagle Grove, Iowa does hereby approve the hiring of one new Police Officer for the Eagle Grove Police Department, respectively Ben Aschenbrenner

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Eagle Grove, Iowa shall compensate Ben Aschenbrenner as a Step 4 Officer with a pay starting at \$37.40 per hour.


The motion was seconded by Council member Limerick and after due consideration thereof, the roll was called and the following Council members voted:
