RESOLUTION 2025-103

RESOLUTION APPROVING INTERIM POLICE CHIEF

WHEREAS, Section 15.03(1) of the City of Eagle Grove Municipal Code of Ordinances, the Mayor of the City of Eagle Grove shall appoint the Police Chief; and,

WHEREAS, Section 17.02(6) of the City of Eagle Grove Municipal Code of Ordinances, the Council shall by Resolution determine compensation of employees or officers; and,

WHEREAS, due to a retirement, on October 24, 2025, at 4:30 p.m., the City of Eagle Grove Police Department will no longer have a Chief of Police; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the Council have defined a qualified person to act as Interim Police Chief until such time as a permanent Police Chief can be appointed; and,

WHEREAS, it is now time for the City Council of the City of Eagle Grove to hereby consider an appointment as required by the City of Eagle Grove Municipal Code of Ordinances; and,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Eagle Grove, Iowa, that the following appointment and compensation is approved:

Captain Mark Hennigar shall be appointed as Interim Police Chief that shall begin on October 24, 2025, at 4:30 p.m. and be compensated to perform such duties an additional \$500.00 per paycheck.




