RESOLUTION INSTALLING TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES AT CERTAIN INTERSECTIONS

WHEREAS, Chapter 61.01 of the City of Eagle Grove Municipal Code of Ordinances establishes how Traffic Control Devices are installed in the City of Eagle Grove; and,

WHEREAS, the following intersections are being considered for additional Traffic Controls:

SW 2nd Street / S. Lincoln Avenue
SW 2nd Street / S. Cedar Avenue

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Eagle Grove hereby believe that installing new Traffic Control Devices is in the best interest of the City of Eagle Grove; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the City Council for the City of Eagle Grove hereby approve and authorize the City of Eagle Grove to install a 4-Way Stop Sign at the intersection of SW 2nd Street and S. Lincoln Avenue and to modify the current Yield Signs to Stop Signs on S. Cedar Avenue at the intersection of SW 2nd Street and S. Cedar Avenue.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the City Council for the City of Eagle Grove shall also authorize City Personnel to record the installation of the aforementioned traffic control devices and authorize the Eagle Grove Police Department to enforce adherence to the newly installed traffic control devices.
