**A RESOLUTION COMMITTING MATCHING FUNDS
FOR A COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT APPLICATION**

WHEREAS, the City of Eagle Grove is applying for an Iowa Community Development Block Grant under the Neighborhood Revitalization portion of the program for a planning project for the Northeast Neighborhood Revitalization Project, and,

WHEREAS, the City has available funding in their General Fund budget in the amount of \$3,750.00 which they are dedicating towards this project for the purpose of matching a CDBG award and implementing a comprehensive planning project to identify and prioritize needs for revitalization of the Northeast Neighborhood.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EAGLE GROVE, IOWA:

SECTION 1. The City commits to the use of these General Funds in the amount of \$3,750.00 for the purpose of funding the City's share of the Northeast Neighborhood Revitalization Planning Project.

SECTION 2. The City commits that these funds are available immediately and that no delay in the planning process will occur as a result of the need to match funds for the project.
