A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION AND GUARENTEEING THE LOCAL MATCH UNDER THE WELLMARK FOUNDATION BUILT ENVIRONMENT MATCH GRANT

WHEREAS, the City of Eagle Grove is eligible to apply for a \$100,000 matching grant through the Wellmark Foundation for certain eligible projects the City is currently pursuing, and;

WHEREAS, the City has an immediate need to increase the availability of clean, safe outdoor community recreation and open spaces for our residents and visitors to enjoy within the community, and;

WHEREAS, the City Council has decided to submit an application to the Wellmark Foundation to aid and assist these very important and needed projects in our community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EAGLE GROVE, IOWA:

SECTION 1. The City Council endorses the submission of an application to the Wellmark Foundation Built Environment Match Grant in the amount of \$100,000.00 for eligible projects.

SECTION 2. The City Council certifies that the required local match is guaranteed to ensure successful project completion.

SECTION 3. The Mayor is authorized to sign all paperwork and forms necessary for the submittal of the grant application.
