RESOLUTION UB2024-03

RESOLUTION AMENDING THE POLICIES AND PROCEDURES FOR THE UTILITIES OF EAGLE GROVE PERTAINING TO THE WATER UTILITY SYSTEM

Whereas, the Eagle Grove Utilities Board of Trustees is authorized to manage the utilities of the City of Eagle Grove, Iowa; and,

Whereas, the Eagle Grove Utilities Board of Trustees, after full discussion and consideration, deemed it advisable to maintain the water utility system for users; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Utilities Board of Trustees for the City of Eagle Grove, Iowa.

Section 1. Sections Modified. Section 2.08 Is hereby repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof:

2.08 METER REPAIRS. Whenever a water meter or water meter reading device owned by the City is found to be out of order by the Water Superintendent, the meter shall be repaired. If it is found that the damage to the meter has occurred due to the carelessness or negligence of the customer or property owner, which includes damage from freezing, then the property owner shall be liable for the cost of repairs, which include parts, labor and a fine not-to-exceed \$500.00. If the meter and/or meter reading device ceases to register due to the age of the meter or meter reading device or is not considered due to carelessness or negligence, then the cost of repairs shall include the cost of the repair which includes parts and labor to install the new meter and/or meter reading device.

Section 2. Repealer. All other resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3. Severability Clause. If any section, provision, or part of this resolution shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication not affect the validity of this resolution as a whole or any section, provision, or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 4. When effective. This resolution shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval, and/or publication as provided by law.


The motion was seconded by Utilities Board of Trustees member Bisson and after due consideration thereof, the roll was called and the following members voted:
